

All-State Band Conductor

BRIAN SPROUL, DMA

Dr. Brian Sproul, DMA, serves as the Director of Athletic Bands at the University of Utah, where he directs the marching band and pep bands; he also teaches conducting and various other courses within the School of Music. Dr. Sproul has appeared extensively throughout the United States and Canada as a guest artist conductor, clinician and adjudicator. He is also well known for his arrangements and drill design for marching band, having written for various programs throughout the country.



Dr. Sproul is a contributing member to the College Band Director's National Association and serves as the Chair of the Pac-12 Athletic Band Director's Association. He is also a contributing author to the Teaching Music Through Performance in Band series, published by GIA Publications and used worldwide.

Under his direction, the University of Utah Marching Band has performed for the 2008 Presidential Inauguration as well as numerous bowl games, including the 2008 Sugar Bowl, and bowls in Las Vegas, San Francisco and Dallas. Dr. Sproul also served as one of the directors of the Salt Lake 2002 Olympic Spirit Band. The Olympic Spirit Band performed at the Opening and Closing Ceremonies as well as many of the venues throughout the games.

Prior to his appointment at Utah he was the Assistant Director of Bands at Clemson University in South Carolina. While at Clemson, he served as the Director of the Jazz Band, Assistant Director of Tiger Band, and Conductor of the Concert Band. He has also served as a high school band director in metro-Atlanta.

Dr. Sproul holds a Doctor of Musical Arts degree in Wind Conducting from the University of Alabama. He received his Bachelor's Degree in Music Education from the University of Georgia and a Master's Degree in Music Education from the University of Utah.

All-State Orchestra Conductor

DAVID E. BECKER

Awarded Professor Emeritus at the University of Wisconsin-Madison in 2005, Professor Becker was Director of Orchestras and the Graduate Orchestral Conducting Program from 1984-2005. The Maestro Becker and the UW Symphony Orchestra received critical acclaim for their international tours to Central Europe (1998) and Spain (2001). He was the Associate Conductor of the Madison Symphony (1985-1992), Music Director/Conductor of the Racine Symphony (WI) (1989-1993), and the recipient of the 2012 Distinguished Service Award from the Wisconsin Chapter of ASTA.

Before moving to Madison in 1984, Professor Becker was Director of Orchestras and Graduate Orchestral Conducting at the University of Miami, Coral Gables while he also served as Assistant Conductor for the Florida Philharmonic. He went to Miami in 1980 from the Oberlin College Conservatory of Music



where he was Associate Professor of Applied Viola and Conductor of the String Arts Ensemble. Other resident conducting appointments have included the Wisconsin (WI), Northern Ohio (Oberlin), Greater Miami (FL) Youth Symphony Orchestras, and the Brevard (NC) and Summer Music Festival.

Professor Becker was the Director of Orchestral Studies at the Lawrence University Conservatory of Music (WI) from 2005-2012. He was the recipient of the Lawrence University 2010 Excellence in Teaching Award and received the Honorary Degree of Master of Arts in recognition of meritorious achievement in 2012. He received the Distinguished Service Award from the Fox Valley Symphony (WI) for his work as the Interim Conductor of the Fox Valley Symphony Youth Orchestra (Appleton, WI) during 2011.

Professor Becker was appointed Director of Orchestral Studies at Texas Tech University, Lubbock, Texas (2013-17). The TTU Symphony Orchestra was the featured University Orchestra at the Texas Music Educators Association Convention in 2015, and the TTU Chamber Orchestra and University Choir performed in Alice Tully Hall at Lincoln Center in May,2017. He also served as the Interim Conductor of the Lubbock Youth Symphony Orchestra for 2014-15. David E. Becker was invited by The Ohio State University beginning August, 2017 to serve as a Visiting Professor-Interim Orchestra Conductor for 2017-18. Mr. Becker's career as an artist violist has included the Atlanta, Syracuse, Savannah, Louisville, Memphis, and Madison Symphonies, the Santa Fe and Miami Operas, the Sewanee (TN), Brevard (NC), and Peninsula (WI) Summer Music Festivals, the resident faculty string quartets at the Universities of Miami, Georgia, Memphis State, Oberlin Conservatory, and the Eduard Melkus String Quartet touring in the U.S. and Europe.

Mr. Becker is widely recognized for his dedication to teaching student musicians which has resulted in high school/university orchestra clinics, and guest conducting Regional and All-State Honor Orchestras in 45 states. Professor Becker was invited to guest conduct the Zhuying Symphony Orchestra in China, the MENC All-National Honors Orchestra, and serve as a clinician for the ASTA National Orchestra Conference, Ohio State University Summer String Teacher's Workshop, Texas Orchestra Directors Association Convention, and the Midwest Band and Orchestra Clinic. In August 2018, Professor retired from academia and is now devoting his time to guest conducting and orchestral conducting clinics around the country.







2018-19 AMEA Music Educator of the Year Award

RON HORNER

Recently retired from teaching, Ron Horner is a veteran teacher of over thirty years, twenty-seven of which have been in Alaska. Participation in Region 1 Music Festivals and All-State events was highly anticipated by Mr. Horner and his music students! The summer of 2016 Ron had the privilege of working with composer Steve Lias, on a National Parks Concert Series Composition piece about the Bering Land Bridge National Park (Between the Tundra and the Sky), written specifically for Ron's Nome-Beltz High School Band and Choir.

Ron's educational background includes a Masters of Education degree from California Lutheran University and a Bachelor of Arts in Music from Whitworth University. Although Ron's first instrument was the accordion, his main instrument is voice. He also plays the guitar, piano, trumpet, baritone and tuba, and enjoys jamming sessions. He and his wife, Kathy, are proud of their five children all of whom are alumni of Nome-Beltz High School.
