All high school groups, (dance groups, drum lines, etc.) interested in performing must also submit a DVD by the deadline, so that if your team makes it to the tournament, your DVD will already have been reviewed.

Remember when submitting your DVD,

- your entire routine must be no longer than 3 minutes in length (an additional minute will be allowed for getting your group on and off the court). **THIS TIME LIMIT IS STRICTLY ADHERED TO.**
- the routine to be performed must be age appropriate and family oriented.
- if you are interested in more than one performance time, please indicate such with your DVD.
- DVDs submitted should contain the routine you intend to perform.
- DVDs will not be returned.
- and, ASAA reserves the right to allow for flexibility in scheduling, and the right to deny a performance group who chooses to use inappropriate dance moves and/or music.

DVDs should be mailed to **Sue Stein, P. O. Box 3466, Soldotna, AK 99669**, and **postmarked no later than February 15, 2008**. Invitations to perform will be sent out by February 29th. If selected, you will be given a performance time slot with your invitation. We look forward to receiving a submission from your group.
