

2021 ASAA/FIRST NATIONAL BANK ALASKA MIX SIX VOLLEYBALL STATE CHAMPIONSHIP POLICIES & PROCEDURES



Location: Dimond High School - Anchorage

Qualifying Process: Each Conference will notify ASAA the name of the school(s) advancing.

Mix Six State Championship Tournament Structure: The Mix Six Championship will consist of 11 teams using a double elimination bracket. Opening round games will be best of 3 (third game will be to 25 points winning by 2) while all winners matches will be best of 5.

Rules: 2020-21 NFHS Volleyball rules will be utilized. In addition, the ASAA Supplemental Rules for Mix Six will be used (located on Page 172-173) of the 2020-21 ASAA Handbook. ASAA Covid-19 Mitigation plans will be followed as well as the NFHS Volleyball rules considerations.

Mandatory Coaches Meeting: There is a mandatory coaches meeting on Wednesday at 6:00 pm for all Head Coaches. This meeting will be held on Zoom. State policies and procedures will be reviewed.

Team Rosters: *Coaches must verify official rosters during the coaches meeting.* A copy of the school's submitted roster will be emailed prior to the meeting. If there are any changes to that roster (name, jersey number), *notify ASAA of any changes at that time.* Following the meeting, no changes to roster personnel may be made. If jersey numbers change, coaches must notify scorekeepers and announcer prior to the start of the game.

Pre-Tournament Practice: ASAA and Dimond High School CAN NOT provide any practice times this year.

Volleyballs: Molten Volleyballs are the Official ASAA State Volleyball. A black/gray colored panel ball will be used for all matches and available for warm-ups. ASAA will provide warm-up and game balls.

Passes: Team participant passes will be based on submitted team roster including a manager. Coach/Adult passes will be issued based on the school's submitted list. Details can be found on pages 97-98 of the ASAA Handbook, in the State Championship Policies.

Looker Rooms: Teams/players are expected to arrive prepared to play.

Bench Area & Personnel Rules:

- Bench personnel is not allowed to exceed the amount of passes issued.
- The maximum number of individuals in the bench area is 16 with 6 on the floor and ten on the bench.
- ONLY team participants and coaching staff are allowed in the bench area.
- Non-roster players are not allowed on the bench unless fulfilling a managerial role with a pass.
- Any coach who is ejected in a previous game may NOT be in the facility for the next game.
- Any players ejected in a game must sit for the next game, under adult supervision, and can be on the bench, but NOT in uniform.
- Due to safety concerns it has been mandated by ASAA that only individuals of Seventh Grade or above may be on the sidelines/bench area during state championship competition.

Yearbook and School/Team Photo/Video: These individuals must remain in the spectator areas. Video service of each game will not be provided by ASAA. Teams are encouraged to make other arrangements if they wish a video copy of their game. If present in non-spectator areas, they will be removed. Only ASAA Credentialed Media are allowed to be outside the spectator area.

Results: All results will be posted online as soon as possible during or following the events each day. Access will be on the Volleyball section of the ASAA.org website.

Event Supervision: Each participating school will be requested to identify an Administrator or other person approved in advance by the Principal who is responsible for the conduct of its coaches, participants and fans throughout the contest, as defined in the ASAA bylaws Article 6, Section 4 on page 26 in the ASAA Handbook. Please have the designees check in with ASAA staff upon arrival at the event.

Spectator Etiquette: There will be no spectators on Friday. Once the Tournament uses ONE court, there will be limited fans allowed. When allowed, all spectators are restricted to the spectators areas.

State Merchandise: Northwest Designs is the Official State Merchandise Vendor. NWD will have a large variety of apparel and feature on-site printing with customized made to order commemorative items. A web store is also available online at ASAA.org/store.

Awards: Awards will be given to the Coach/Administrator at the end of their match or the end of the tournament.

Team Awards:

- 1st and 2nd Place Team Trophies
- Academic Award.
- Sportsmanship Award.

Individual Awards:

- Medals for members of the first and second place teams.
- Medals for the twelve members of the All-Tournament Team.
- Certificate for the Player of the Match athletes.
- Certificate for Good Sport Team athletes.

Participation Fee: The Board of Directors has authorized the assessment of a participation fee for all state championships and festivals. The fee for athletic teams will be \$10 per student participant with a maximum fee of \$150 for those teams of 15 or more participants.

MIX SIX VOLLEYBALL MATCH PROTOCOL

Warm-Up Time: Each team must be at the match site at least 15 minutes prior to their respective match. Each team must provide all their own materials and supplies – including tape if athletes are going to be taped. The four teams that are scheduled to play the next matches will be permitted to warm-up in the Auxiliary Gym 30 minutes prior to the scheduled game time.

Bracket Play: The warm up time on the playing court before your scheduled match will go as follows. If matches are running behind teams will have a minimum of 9 minutes to warm up on the playing court.

- 9:00 - Serving team gets court for warm-ups include serving.
- 5:00 - Receiving team gets court for warm-ups including serving.
- 1:00 - Both teams report to bench for instructions.

Home/Visitor: The team on TOP of bracket is HOME.

Introductions:

- Friday: No introductions and announcements
- Saturday - Championship Game Only - All players will be introduced.
- Following introductions, players return to bench for one minute.

Pledge of Allegiance / National Anthem:

The National Anthem will be conducted at the beginning of Friday and before the championship game, unless otherwise noted by ASAA Tournament Staff.
