## Fan Code of Conduct

ASAA acknowledges that fan enthusiasm and support are a great part of high school athletics and activities. Active enthusiasm and cheering is encouraged. ASAA is committed to creating a safe, comfortable, and enjoyable environment for all fans, parents, coaches, volunteers, and participants. Sportsmanship and respect toward opponents, championship officials and staff is expected at all times.

We want all fans attending our state championships to enjoy the experience in a responsible fashion. When attending a contest, you are required to refrain from the following behaviors and actions (list is not all inclusive):

- Behavior that is unruly, disruptive, or illegal in nature. This includes fighting, taunting, harassing, nudity, or any other acts/behavior in the judgement of state championship management that diminish a fans enjoyment of the contest.
- Foul, abusive language or obscene gestures
- Interference with the progress of the contest, which includes throwing objects onto the area of contest.
- Laser pointers, whistles, and air-horns are prohibited. Thunder sticks and other artificial noise makers are banned from indoor events. Additional prohibitions may be enforced by the hosting school district in accordance with established policies, procedures and local laws. NFHS rules may restrict other items.
- Selling tickets or other merchandise without permission from ASAA.
- All ASAA events are tobacco, alcohol, and drug free.
- Fans must clean up their area following any contest. Schools may be billed for additional clean up costs.
- Failing to follow instructions of state championship personnel.

Fans are responsible for their conduct. ASAA and state championship staff will intervene to support an environment where fans, parents, volunteers, and participants, can enjoy the event free from the above behavior. Fans at ASAA events who violate these provisions will be subject to ejection without refund or prior warning and potential loss of ticket privileges for future events. ASAA's thanks you for adhering to our Fan Code of Conduct.

**Sportsmanship Creed:** "ASAA and its corporate sponsors appreciate your attendance at this game. This contest is being played under the authority of the Alaska School Activities Association. ASAA rules provide for fair play and good sportsmanship among everyone involved. All participants and coaches are expected to exhibit the highest level of respect for their opponents and the officials. We also expect fans will eagerly support their favorite team by applauding fair play while refraining from negative words and behaviors." "Be Loud... Be Proud... but Be Positive."

**Photography and Video Taping:** No flash photography. Photography and video taping from the stands and spectator area is allowed. Fans, parents, coaches, school employees, etc. are not allowed to photograph outside the spectator area. Those areas are reserved for working members of the media and ASAA's official photographer.

**Passes:** Anyone attempting to enter ASAA events with a fraudulent pass will be denied entry and may be removed from the facility and denied entrance.
