



ASAA WPI EXPLANATION

The WPI stands for Winning Percentage Index. It is a measure of strength of schedule and how a team does against that schedule.

It does not consider things like margin of victory or where a game is played, only whether or not a team won. **Only games against other Alaskan schools in your classification are counted in the WPI.**

Therefore, games played with other teams outside the state or outside your classification are not included. The WPI is tabulated and operated by ASAA and is released at least twice a season.

The WPI Two Main Categories:

1. Your team's win-loss record (50% of WPI)
2. Your corrected win-loss record of all your opponents (50%).

Note: The corrected win-loss is used as to not get credit for a win in the first category and a loss in the second category.
