2003 ASAA/First National Bank Alaska Drama-Debate-Forensics (DDF) State High School Championships Results

The 2003 ASAA/First National Bank Alaska Drama-Debate-Forensics Championships took place April 10-12 in Anchorage. Service High School hosted the first day, and the University of Alaska-Anchorage s Lucy Cuddy Center was the DDF site on April 11-12.

We had very experienced, talented DDF co-directors in Dan Henry and Steve Johnson, who are both assistant professors of communication and speech/drama coaches at UAA, said Gary Matthews, executive director of the Alaska School Activities Association (ASAA). We appreciate their hard work, along with the volunteer help of numerous UAA communications students.

As final award points were being tallied late afternoon Saturday, several competitors were chosen to deliver a command performance. These upbeat, colorful performances were met with considerable enthusiasm from the audience of nearly 200 peers and their DDF coaches.

DDF competitors from the Lower Yukon School District and from Wrangell also participated in the state tournament. Three small schools — Haines, Nikiski and Whitestone - took advantage of a new ruling allowing all participating schools, regardless of size, to have up to 15 entries in the DDF state competition. Previously, smaller schools (with enrollments of 400 or less) were limited to a maximum of 12 competitors.

The DDF competition, like all other state-level high school interscholastic championships, are sponsored by the Alaska School Activities Association (ASAA), a statewide non-profit organization formed in 1956 to direct, develop and support Alaska's high school interscholastic sports, academic and fine arts activities. As ASAA s premier sponsor, First National Bank Alaska is a co-sponsor of state high school championships. ASAA is also supported by three major sponsors: AT&T Alascom, Alaska Commercial Company (ACC) and KTUU-TV Channel 2 (Anchorage).
