As of fall 2010 12th grade Immersion/Native Speaker will not be able to compete unless new tests are created.

1. All students must meet eligibility requirements before being registered.
2. Each student will complete a multiple choice scantron format test of 50 questions. Many of the questions are taken from the “Teacher’s Discovery” trivia card sets. However, some questions will be taken from other sources, in order to make the tests more challenging. Only the “Teacher’s Discovery” source is revealed as a source of questions to study in advance. Other sources will not be made known, as it is assumed that culture is taught in the language classes, and that students would learn culture other ways besides the “Teacher’s Discovery” sets.
3. The tests for levels 1 and 2 will be in English, while those for levels 3, 4, AP and immersion/native speaker will be in the target language.
4. Participants are requested to bring their own number 2 pencils. However, pencils will also be available at the contest).
5. Seating at the tables in the testing area will be mixed languages. Students may not sit next to those of the same language.
6. Students may not have photocopied question/answer sheet packets or visible electronic devices with them in the testing area. Those caught with either during the test may be disqualified (at the discretion of the test proctors and/or contest directors).
7. A minimum of 25 points is required to place.
