STATE BASKETBALL TEAM QUALIFIERS

Conference Tournament Directors/Hosts once you know state qualifiers and place in your conference, <u>PLEASE</u> email <u>championships@asaa.org</u> with that information ASAP! Basketball teams that qualify for state here are a few things you need to do. The sooner we can receive this information the better for us to prepare for March Madness Alaska.

- Review the March Madness Alaska submission deadlines for rosters, photos, season record information, 1A/2A skills contest, academic award etc.
- PLEASE fill out the state championship forms online as soon as you can Basketball Online Forms.
- Get your team picture to ASAA as soon as you can via the photo upload form or state roster form Basketball Online Forms.
- Review the <u>1A/2A or 3A/4A March Madness Alaska Policies and</u> Procedures. This contains information coaches and AD's need.

1A/2A STATE SEEDING

The 1A/2A seeding committee has met the few months to review team records from this year. Please make sure your team has their schedule and results in <u>ASAA365.com</u>. ALL schedules/results for 1A/2A are important so the committee has the best information for seeding once qualifiers are determined.



3A/4A BASKETBALL "AT-LARGE" SELECTION & SEEDING PROCESS

Each team will be given a point value of .5 or one against each other team being considered. Points will be assigned using the following ranked criteria (Endowment games are not considered). If there is a tie, the same criteria will be used to break the tie, disregarding the other teams. If the tie still exist there will be coin toss by ASAA staff to determine who advances.

- 1. Head to Head Record
- 2. Record against common state qualifiers at all classifications.*
- 3. Record against common opponents at all classifications.*
- 4. Record against common state qualifiers at that classifications.*
- 5. Record against common opponents at that classification.*
 - * in order to utilize this criteria the winning percentage must have a difference of at least 25%

4A Basketball "At-Large" Pools

To comprise the 4A at-large pool with the following:

- Cook Inlet and Northern Lights third and fourth place teams
- Northern Lights third and fourth place teams
- Mid-Alaska and Southeast Conference second place teams
- Southeast Conference second place teams

3A Basketball "At-Large" Pools

To comprise the 3A at-large pool with the following:

- Aurora third and fourth place teams
- Southcentral Conferences third and fourth place teams
- Southeast Conference second place teams
- Western Conference third place teams







ALASKA AIRLINES CENTER PARKING

<u>Parking at the Alaska Airlines Center is FREE!!</u> Free Parking is provided by ASAA. The Alaska Airlines Center March Madness Alaska Parking Map will help you find the best and most available parking during the event. You can also download this map at <u>ASAA365.com</u> or <u>ASAA.org</u>

- Reserved Lot (Purple Color): DO NOT PARK HERE unless you have a Reserved Lot Pass. If so, and don't have a pass, you will receive a \$250 fine from UAA.
- Team Parking (Yellow Color): This area is for teams playing, officials, and some staff. There are a limited number of spaces. It is first come first serve.
- Providence Parking Garages (Blue Color): Do not park in there until AFTER 5:00pm! Providence is letting us use that space after hours to help with parking. Please do not abuse it.



SCHOOL PEP BANDS

While duel courts are being used, pep bands will not be able to perform. However, on Saturday when all games are played on one court, Pep Bands are encouraged to come and play for their team. On Saturday, drums and electric guitars are allowed if they are not large set ups and don't require lots of power. School Pep Bands wanting to attend must email Isaiah Vreeman (isaiah@asaa.org) by 5pm Monday the week of the tournament. Arrangements for entering the facility will be discussed at that time. Pep Bands will be allowed to play some during pre-game, timeouts, quarter breaks, and halftime. Pep bands will have to share with cheer teams, possibly other pep bands, crowd interaction items, scheduled halftime entertainment, and PA announcements. ASAA cannot commit to a certain amount of play time. The championship game table coordinator will meet with the Director prior to the game beginning, to work out timing of playing and announcing duties.

YEARBOOK PHOTOS & TEAM VIDEO

These individuals must remain in the spectator areas. Special and limited arrangements can be made for a school yearbook staff student if you contact Isaiah Vreeman (isaiah@asaa.org) on the Monday prior to the event, if not, access will not be allowed. School Yearbook staff includes the yearbook teacher and a student enrolled in yearbook class. Yearbook teachers must have a yearbook student with them at all times. Only ASAA Credentialed Media are allowed to be outside the spectator area and designated media locations unless otherwise approved by Isaiah Vreeman.




