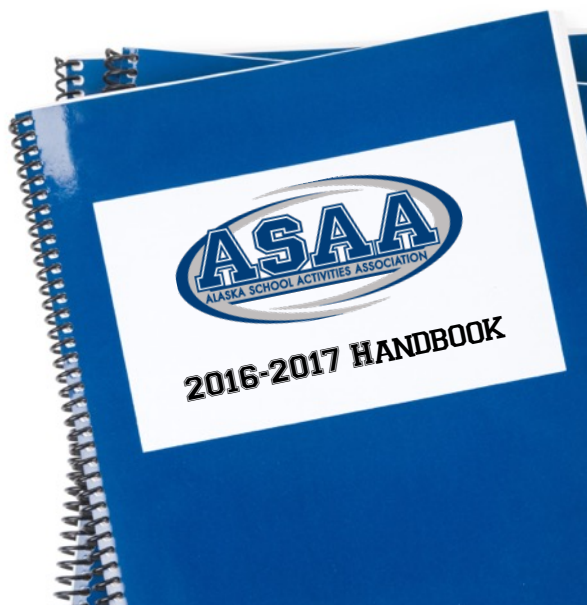

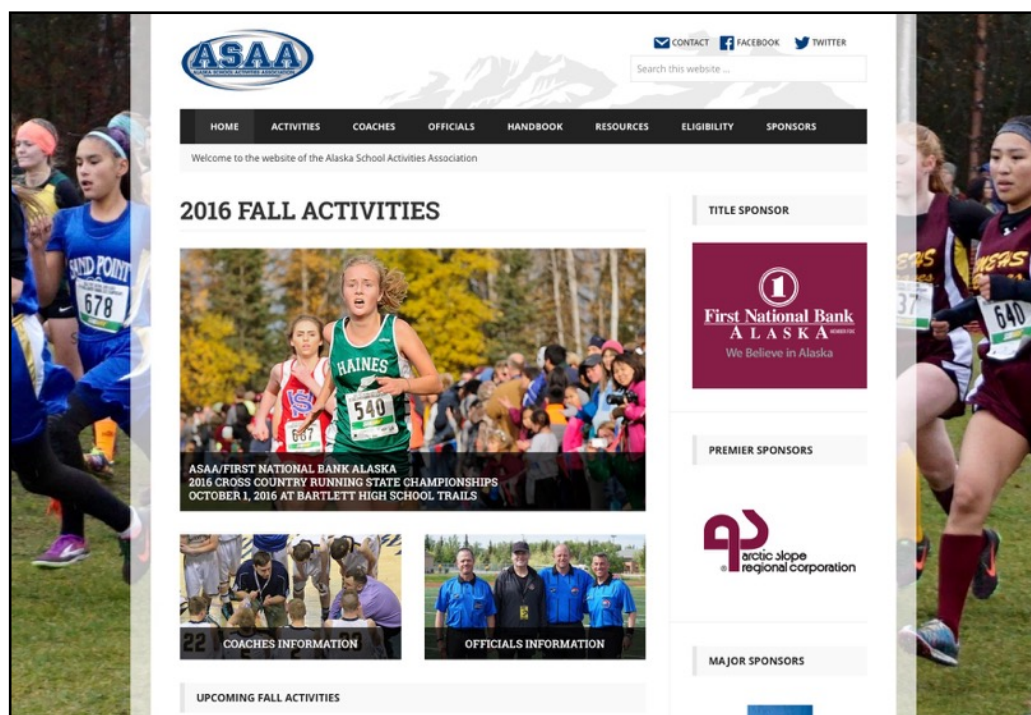
ASAA Handbook Online & Digital

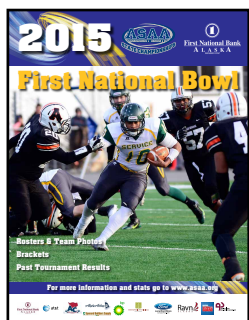
2016-17 brings some changes to the Tobacco, Alcohol, and Controlled Substances policies and penalties.

NEW TAD DVD's

Last spring, the ASAA Board of Control approved slight changes to the TAD policy. As a result, the previous DVDs are obsolete. Please discard all four of the previous DVDs. Both of the current ones have been posted to the web site asaaeligibility.org or playforkeepsalaska.org. Students and parent(s) must watch a TAD Orientation DVD and sign the form before their student is eligible to participate in interscholastic sports/activities.

Football: Large School Quarterfinals & Small Schools Semifinals

There has been some ambiguity on who is “in charge” of certain tasks and operational items, for the Large Schools Quarterfinals and the Small Schools Semifinals. Starting this year ASAA has decided that the Large School Quarterfinals and Small Schools Semifinals will be under full control of the schools/conference.

This means schools that participate in these games will not have to pay the ASAA participation fee, subject to ASAA media policies or broadcast rights, or submit rosters, season record info, etc to ASAA. These games are now referred to as “Play In Games”, with the winners getting a berth to the ASAA First National Bowl Series which ASAA hosts this year at Palmer HS and Anchorage Football Stadium.



Roster & Season Record Information Online State Championship Forms

ALL teams are REQUIRED to fill out both the State Championship Roster and Team Season Record Online Form. However, this year there is a small change to the online State Championship Roster and Team Season Record form. The online form will included an option where you input players or game schedule, to select “MY ROSTER IS UP-TO-DATE ON ASAA365” or “MY SCHEDULE & RESULTS ARE UP-TO-DATE ON ASAA365”. Concussion Reporting

If you have a student that suffers a concussion, please report it on the *student information* page found on the Electronic Eligibility Reporting (EER) form.

- This information will help the ASAA staff track concussion incidents which the State of Alaska has requested.
- You will also find a *Concussion Form Box* underneath the current TAD box on the *Edit Student* page (on the EER form) to verify students have been given the information and have signed the form.
- It is mandatory that all coaches are current in a Concussion Awareness or Concussion Management course in order to be certified.

Pre-Participation Physicals

Recent changes in the State regulation now allow chiropractors to administer physicals. This has necessitated a change in ASAA Bylaws that the Board will address this fall. In the mean time, those students that have already had a physical by a chiropractor can become eligible by noting such has occurred via the waiver process. Otherwise, starting August 15, 2016 students can meet eligibility requirements through a physical administered by a chiropractor.
