ASAA BOARD OF DIRECTORS APRIL SPRING MEETING UPDATE

ASAA Board of Directors Spring Meeting was April 22-24 in Kotzebue. The city of Kotzebue and the High School were great hosts. The ASAA Board learns a lot about different areas and their challenges during the Spring Meeting. Next year Kodiak will host the Spring Meeting. In addition, the Board conducted a May meeting via teleconference.

HIGHLIGHTS FROM THE MEETING

Below are some of the highlights from both meetings. You can find detailed minutes on the ASAA website under Resources/Board of Directors - <u>Un-Adopted Minutes of the Board Meeting</u>.



- Baseball Mercy Rule Policy: The Rollover rule was added until after 4.5 inning when the regular mercy rule goes into effect.
- **State Spirit Competition Format (State Cheer Competition):** Game Day was adopted for 2019. It will include a dance component with the two additional components to be determined during the October Board Meeting.
- Basketball & Hockey Cheerleading: Adopted a 12 participant limit.
- **Daily Participation Limits:** Amended the Article 7 Section 8 bylaw for Daily Participation Limits for basketball, flag football, hockey, and soccer <u>Details Link</u>
- Wrestling: Adopted new weight classes for details see May Board Meeting minutes Details Link
- **DII Football:** Approved in DII higher seeds host the semifinal games beginning with 2019 season. NOTE: The 2018 DII semifinals will be hosted by Palmer. See May Board Meeting minutes for specific details on all levels of playoffs.
- Track and Field Reporting & Alternate Procedures: Revised the following Track and Field policies:
 - All conference meets are required to utilize <u>athletic.net</u>.
 - The top 16 qualifiers and up to three alternates will be post Monday morning.
 - All qualified participants are automatically accepted. Coaches must accept alternates by Monday 6:00 PM by emailing schreck@asaa.org.
 - Coaches should decline those entries not attending the state meet by Wednesday 6:00 PM. To decline, the school will need to unregister the entry on athletic.net.
 - If there is a declared scratch at the Coach's Meeting, ASAA will invite the next available alternate that is already qualified into the meet in another event.
- Jamboree and Wrestling Take-down Tournament Practice Requirements: Adopted to require all athletes to have 5 separate days of practice prior to a jamboree or take-down tournament.
- State Championship Future Sites: 3A/4A Volleyball was approved for the Alaska Airlines Center 2018-19-20-21, Tennis was approved for Alaska Club East for 2019-20-21, Mix Six/2A Volleyball will be at Dimond HS for 2019-20-21, DII Hockey was approved for 2019 at the Menard Center, Cross Country Running will be at Bartlett for 2019-20-21, and Wrestling will be decided at the October Board Meeting.
- 2A Basketball Conference Realignment: Approved to move Tikigaq, Unalakleet and Selawik to Southwest Conference, berths and conference names to be decided at the October Board Meeting.
- Valdez HS Region Placement: Approved to move Valdez to Region 6.
- **Discussion Items:** Change the boys wrestling weight classes, system for selecting at-large berths & seeding the 3A/4A basketball tournament, DI/DII hockey seeding, football scheduling and playoff procedures, and more. <u>Details Link</u>


