# NON-APPROVED NIKE HYPERELITE NFHS BASKETBALL

This past spring the NFHS was notified of a NIKE ball, HyperElite, that had been produced but could not be used by the NFHS high school community because it does not meet the description as outlined in the Basketball Rules book. NIKE has an approved ball whose name is close to the one not allowed. The NIKE Elite Championship ball is one that has been on our list of approved balls since 2009 and may be used by your high schools. The NIKE HyperElite is the ball that is not approved and should not be used by the high schools.

The Elite Championship, on the left, is approved. The HyperElite, on the right, is not approved.
