Revised Article 7 Section 5

Section 5 - Addition or Suspension of Sanctioned Activities

A. Adding Sanctioned Activities: The Board of Directors may sanction additional interscholastic activities to those listed under Section 4 upon request of member schools or districts. To be approved for full sanctioning, an activity must have met the following criteria:

- 1. Must have 6 or more schools that are currently competing in the sport/activity.
- 2. At least 8 schools must sign an emerging status application and commit to continuing their program in emerging status.
- 3. Gain approval by the Board of Directors to be deemed emerging.
- 4. Remain in emerging status for a minimum of 2 years and maximum of 5 years.
- 5. Must reach 12 teams of registered and fully participating teams for two years before becoming eligible for approval as fully sanctioned interscholastic.
- 6. If it does not reach 12 teams in 5 years, it is sent back to the Board for review to either provide additional time or remove it from Emerging Status.

Requests to sanction should be directed to the Association no later than April 15 for all activities.
