BADMINTON

ALL CLASSIFICATIONS

Participation in girls' events shall be limited to individuals who were assigned female at birth. To align with ASAA bylaws regarding double division sports, students assigned female at birth are prohibited from competing in both Singles and Girls Singles events during the same school year. In Mixed Doubles, where one teammate must be a female assigned female at birth, a player cannot fill both an open spot in Mixed Doubles and a spot reserved for females assigned female at birth during the same season."

A. SEASON

2025-2026 SEASON

March 4, 2026 - First Practice

March 20, 2026 - First Contest

*Participants must be entered in the School Activities Reporting System (SARS) prior to First Contest (Article 12 Section 10).

May 5, 2026 - Last Contest (Regular Season or Conference Championship)

B.MINIMUM DAYS PRACTICE

Each participant must have a minimum of 10 different days of physical practice before the first day of competition. (Article 7, Section 7)

C. INDIVIDUAL NON-SCHOOL PARTICIPATION

ASAA has no limitations on students participating on non-school badminton teams while they are members of a school badminton team.

D. RULES

- 1. Badminton World Federation Simplified Rules
- 2. A player may compete in five (5) divisions:

Singles Girls Singles*

Doubles Girls Doubles* Mix Doubles**

E. CONFERENCES

Badminton teams are not categorized into conferences.

F. MAXIMUM MEETS

ASAA does not place a limit on the number of badminton meets that an athlete or team may compete in during a season.

G. STATE CHAMPIONSHIP

Currently there is no state championship for badminton as it does not meet the criteria.
