The goal of this activity is to foster and inspire technical achievement, aesthetic understanding and critical listening skills. Students pre-qualify for participation at the State Solo and Ensemble Music Festival by receiving a "I" or "Superior" rating at a qualifying festival. For the 2019 State Solo & Ensemble Music Festival, there are 497 entries involving 789 students from 42 Alaskan high schools... a daunting task for two days. To perform at the Command Performance Concert, students must be nominated by the state adjudicator for each adjudicated section.

Years of dedicated hard work to develop your talents have paid off. 
