Softball (DI & DII)	\$45 per game \$75 per game for Championships \$650 for entire classification tournament (16 games - pool play & bracket)

- Radio stations showing up last minute requesting space to broadcast, or not seeking permission to broadcast the event will be assessed a late fee. The fee is determined based on the season, event, and timing of the request. Credentials and future broadcasting considerations could be affected.
- All television "live or delayed" broadcasts of any state championship events is strictly prohibited by ASAA and its Television Broadcast Rights Holder, GCI, without their express written consent.
- All webcast/webstream/digital "live or delayed" broadcasts of any state championship events is strictly prohibited by ASAA and its Digital Rights Holder, National Federation High School (NFHS) Network, without their express written consent. This includes Facebook Live and other live social media video platforms.
