



2021 ASAA/First National Bank Alaska Swim & Dive State Championships Policies & Procedures

Dates: Friday, November 5 and Saturday, November 6, 2021

Location: Bartlett Pool - Anchorage

Qualifying Process: Swimmers/Divers must compete in a conference meet in order to qualify for the state championship meet.

- **Individual Swimming Events:** The first place finisher from each conference qualifying meet is automatically qualified. Each conference's next top seven (7) swimmers will be considered for qualifications for the next twelve best statewide times gaining qualification to the State Meet. Should the Conference winner decide not to attend state, that position cannot be transferred to the second place finisher in that conference.
- **Berths from conferences which use and 8-lane pool:** Only those 8 in the finals will be submitted for qualification.
- **Berths from conferences, which use a 6-lane pool:** The top 6 qualifiers in the finals will be considered for qualification. Consolation finals will be held to determine the times for the 7th and 8th swimmers in the prelims. The 7th and 8th top qualifiers will swim in lanes 3 & 4 of the consolation finals. Their times IN THIS RACE will also be considered for qualification. *(Note: In the event that another swimmer in consolation finals swims faster than the swimmers in lanes 3 and 4, their times would not be considered, as their times in the prelims did not put them in the top 8.)*
- **Relay Events:** The first (1) place relay team from each conference qualifying meet finals, plus the next four (4) fastest overall team times statewide, for a total of eight (8) relay teams.
- **Diving Events:** The top two (2) finishers from each conference qualifying meet finals plus the next eight (8) best scores will qualify for a total of 16 divers.

Alternate/Substitution: In the event a qualified contestant is unable to compete due to extenuating circumstances (illness, injury, and ineligibility), it is the responsibility of the school of the indisposed contestant(s) to notify ASAA, by the deadline on Wednesday November 3 at 11:00 am. Once notified, ASAA will invite the next athlete with the best qualifying time. This substitution must be an ASAA eligible contestant. After the deadline, if someone is not able to compete, that spot will not be filled.

- **Relays:** All team members originally named in the conference relays, up to 8, not only those who swam, are eligible to be placed in the relay after the Wednesday deadline following all NFHS rules for relay alternate swimmers.
- **Divers:** Alternates that are invited to state meet must submit dive sheets at the time of accepting the invite. First and second alternates can submit dive sheets early in case they become participants.

Diving Entries: Diving coaches must submit dive sheets through www.cleanentries.com by 6pm on 11/3/2021. The diving meet in Cleanentries is titled "2021 ASAA Dive Championships, Alaska"

Rosters/Qualifiers: ASAA is using PlanetHS for its School Activities Reporting System (SARS). Schools will need to indicate which students have qualified for state. This can be done by accessing the Swimming & Diving Varsity Roster and indicating the student is a state qualifier. Submissions are due by Tuesday November 2nd.

Seeding: A seeding committee will combine conference results and draw the preliminary heats which will be posted on asaa.org Monday, November 1st.

Schedule: The Swim & Dive State Meet schedule is posted on ASAA.org on the Swim & Dive state information page.

5:00 PM - 7:00 PM Available for both swimming and diving.

Mandatory Coaches Meeting: There will be a mandatory Coaches meeting on Thursday Nov. 4 at 6:00 PM at the Bartlett Pool. All policies and procedures including COVID mitigations will be reviewed, as well as coach's packets, schedule, and passes. The meeting can also be attended via zoom. If you are unable to attend please email sandi@asaa.org and she will send you a link for the meeting

Passes: Team participant passes will be based on submitted team rosters. Coach/Adult passes will be issued based on certified coaches listed in PlanetHS.

Coaches File Folders: There will be coaches file folders at the entry of the pool area on deck. This will be used as a tool during the meet to spread any news, changes, updates, and more, please check regularly.

Rules: The 2021-2022 NFHS Swimming and Diving rules will govern the conduct of this Championship.

Results: All results will be posted online as soon as possible during or following the events each day. Results will be on the Swim & Dive section of the ASAA.org website.

Appeals: Procedure will be discussed at the coaches meeting

Meet Regulations:

- All participants must obtain pre-participation COVID testing and submit verification. (See ASAA pre-participation testing)
- Due to limited space only state qualifying swimmers, divers and their coaches may attend the state meet. For the 2021 meet managers are not allowed to attend.
- Masks or face coverings are required for all individuals attending the meet. Athletes may remove their mask when they are competing.
- NO shaving on the premises. Penalty is disqualification from the State Meet.
- The shallow end of the pool is available for warm-up and warm-down during competition. No diving.
- Teams will be assigned areas in the upstairs bleachers. This is where athletes should be when they are not warming up, warming down or competing.
- Please clean up your area when you leave for the day.

Deck Protocols:

- Changing on the deck is prohibited
- The deck area is for officials, coaches (max 2 per school) and athletes that are warming up, warming down or competing.
- Only athletes that are going to the blocks/boards will be allowed on the east wall (nearest lane 8)
- Coaches may observe races from the lane 1 side of the pool. Coaches are asked to move to the downstairs bleachers when they do not have an athlete competing.

Diving Videographers: Videotaping dives from the Coaches area or deck level is prohibited. Videotaping from the spectator area is allowed. If you need certain angles for Diving All-American submission, you must apply for a deck access by sending an email to arcticdc@gmail.com. The deadline for submitting request is Tuesday November 2nd at 5:00 PM. Only those people who have applied and been approved will be able to film on the lower level in a designated area shown by ASAA staff. This area will be away from the dive judges.

Team Photographers/Videographers: Team photographers/videographers ARE NOT allowed on the deck during the meet. Only ASAA Credentialed Media are allowed on the deck in areas not interfering with the state meet.

Spectators: Spectators will be limited to 2 per swimmer/diver. Schools will receive slips at the coaches meeting. These slips are required in order to pay for entry into the event. Friday will have separate slips for each session (diving, girls and boys). For Saturday, the number of slips each school receives will be based on the number of individuals qualifying into the finals. The slip on Saturday is valid for all of the finals. On both days each session will stamp hands for those needing to leave and return during the same session. Schools will need to coordinate how to issue the slips to parents and others. Spectators must wear masks at all time and are restricted to the areas above the swim/dive deck.

Spectator Etiquette: Quiet is essential prior to the start of each race. All cell phones must be on silent. In accordance with ASAA policy, artificial noise makers are not allowed at this event. There must be NO flash photography at the start of a swim race or at any time during the diving events.

State Merchandise: Northwest Designs is the Official State Merchandise Vendor. NWD will have a large variety of apparel and feature on-site printing with customized made to order commemorative items. A web store is also available online at ASAA.org/store.

Concessions/Hospitality: No concessions will be available. Athletes should plan ahead and bring their own food. Limited hospitality for workers. Coaches should plan ahead and bring their own food

Awards: Individual Awards are presented throughout the day during finals.

Team Awards:

- 1st and 2nd Place Team Trophies
- Academic Awards for Boys and Girls
- Sportsmanship Awards for Boys and Girls

Individual Awards:

- Medals for the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th place individuals in each event
- Outstanding Competitor Award for Boys and Girls

Participation Fee: The fee for Swim & Dive is \$10 per student participant with no maximum. Once the deadline for withdrawals and substitutions has passed, the roster will be considered final and schools will be invoiced following the event.
