



ASAA BASKETBALL AT-LARGE SELECTION & SEEDING CRITERIA

Basketball “At-Large” Selection and Seeding Process

Each team will be given a point value of .5 or one against each other team being considered. Points will be assigned using the following ranked criteria (Endowment games ARE considered). If there is a tie, the same criteria will be used to break the tie, disregarding the other teams. If the tie still exist there will be coin toss by ASAA staff to determine who advances.

1. Head to Head Record
2. Record against common state qualifiers at all classifications.*
3. Record against common opponents at all classifications.*
4. Record against common state qualifiers at that classifications.*
5. Record against common opponents at that classification.*

* in order to utilize this criteria the winning percentage must have a difference of at least 25%

4A Basketball “At-Large” Pools: The 4A at-large pool will be the following:

- Cook Inlet Conference 3rd and 4th place teams
- Northern Lights Conference 3rd and 4th place teams
- Mid-Alaska Conference second place team
- Southeast Conference second place team

2A Basketball “At-Large” Pools: The 3A at-large pool will be the following:

- Great Alaska Conference 3rd place team
- Interior Conference 3rd place team
- Southeast Conference 3rd place team
- Western Coastal Conference 2nd place team

Note: 3A and 1A Basketball classifications do not have At-Large berths.

Basketball Bracketing Process

- **3A/4A:** Once the at-large teams are selected (4A), the tournament will be seeded using the same criteria with a pool made up of the eight teams.
- **1A/2A:** Once the at-large teams are selected (2A) both tournaments will be seeded by an ASAA Seeding Committee composed of representatives from Regions 1, 2 and 5.
