Location: Bettye Davis East High School – Anchorage

ENTRIES:

- Students must meet all ASAA and school district eligibility standards.
- Students must be entered on the School Activities Reporting System (SARS).
- Students must qualify in every event they enter. They may enter up to 3 events (See DDF Handbook)
- Schools may enter up to 15 students. Only 3 entries per non-debate event, except Reader's Theatre and Extemporaneous Commentary, which are limited to 2 entries. No more than 9 total entries across all debate events.

TOURNAMENT REQUIREMENTS: Due to COVID-19 the following are required

All participants must obtain pre-participation COVID testing and submit verification. (See ASAA pre-participation testing)
Masks or face coverings are required for all individuals attending the tournament.

TIMERS: We need timers. Let us know if you are available. Also, please encourage your students to volunteer when they are not competing.

COACHES: Please ensure that, at least, one coach is present with your students at all times throughout the tournament. This individual will be responsible for chaperoning your students and may be called upon to serve as a judge.

EVENT SUPERVISION: Each participating school will be requested to identify an Administrator or other person approved in advance by the Principal who is responsible for the conduct of its coaches, participants and fans throughout the contest, as defined in the ASAA bylaws Article 6, Section 4. Please have the designees check in with ASAA staff upon arrival at the event.

PARTICIPATION FEE: The Board of Directors has authorized the assessment of a participation fee for all state championships and festivals. The fee for DDF is \$20 per student participant.

AWARDS: Awards are presented at the end of the tournament.

Team Awards: For Division I & Division II

- 1st and 2nd Place Team Trophies
- 1st place trophy in Debate, Drama, & Forensics
- Academic Award
- Sportsmanship Award

Individual Awards:

- Medals for 1st – 4th place in each event.
