ROSTER SUBMISSION

 Oct 5 - rosters entered into the School Activities Reporting System via Big Teams

MATCH FORMAT

- Main Bracket 2 out of 3, regular scoring, 3rd set 10 point tie-breaker
- Elimination Bracket 4 game sets with regular tiebreakers, switch sides every 6 points in all tie-breakers
- Championship (#16) 2 out of 3 with a full 3rd set
- If match -(#17) set to 4 with 10 point tie-breaker

SEEDING

- Coaches must submit seeding form for any possible seeded athletes.
- 2-4 competitors seeded in each division
- Competitors not seeded randomly drawn in

SCORING

Team scores will be determined by points earned by the top 5 finishers in each division 1st - 35, 2nd - 25, 3rd -20, 4th - 15, 5th - 10 (5 for each team)

PASSES

Certified coaches will be issued passes and must have them on to be behind the curtain. Admin passes available on arrival

CHECK-IN

- Players need to check-in and be ready to play one hour prior to scheduled time
- Tardiness: 5 minute delay = 1 game forfeit, loss of toss

10 minute delay = 2 game forfeit, loss of toss

15 minute delay = 3 game forfeit, loss of toss

16 minute delay = match forfeit

WARM-UP

Limited to 5 minutes from the time the players receive the balls

CONDUCT

- Tennis lounge for state qualified athletes and certified tennis coaches
- No coaching while the players are on the court.
- Coaching allowed between sets for a maximum of 2 minutes.
- Show respect to all players

UNIFORM

- Players must come ready to play
- Shirts with name or logo of the school required
- Shoes must have a non marking sole

FOOD/WATER

Food and drink is limited to the lounge Non glass bottles of water are allowed in the balcony

MEDICAL

- Medical coverage will be provided by Orthopedic Physicians Alaska (OPA).
- Ice will be available in emergencies.

PHOTOGRAPHY/VIDEOGRAPHY

- ASAA credential media only allowed outside the spectator area
- Schools may request one team photographer outside the spectator area

EVENT SUPERVISION

Each school must designate an administrator to oversee team and fan conduct Check in with ASAA staff required (ASAA bylaws Article 6, Section 4, State Championship Policies #22)
