# **HOCKEY AT-LARGE & SEEDING CRITERIA**

# **Division II Hockey**

#### At-Large:

The pool will be comprised of the fifth & sixth place teams from the Railbelt and the 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> place teams from the Aurora. This will be determined by the conference bylaws and could be based on the conference tournament or regular season results.

Each team in the "pool" will be given a point value of .5 or one against each other team being considered. Points will be assigned using the following ranked criteria. If there is a tie, the same criteria will be used to break the tie, disregarding the other teams. If the tie still exists, there will be coin toss by ASAA staff to determine who advances

- 1. Head to head record.
- 2. Record against common opponents at all classifications.
- 3. Record against common state qualifiers at that classification.
- 4. Record against common opponents at that classification.

## Seeding:

Once the two at-large teams are selected, then the tournament will be seeded using the same criteria with a "new pool" made up of the eight teams.

# **Division I Hockey**

### At-Large:

The pool will be comprised of the fifth & sixth place teams from the Cook Inlet, the 3<sup>rd</sup> place team from the Mid Alaska and the DII Champion. This will be determined by the conference bylaws and could be based on the conference tournament or regular season results.

Each team in the "pool" will be given a point value of .5 or one against each other team being considered. Points will be assigned using the following ranked criteria. If there is a tie, the same criteria will be used to break the tie, disregarding the other teams. If the tie still exists, there will be coin toss by ASAA staff to determine who advances

- 1. Head to head record.
- 2. Record against common opponents at all classifications.
- 3. Record against common state qualifiers at that classification.
- 4. Record against common opponents at that classification.

## Seeding:

Once the two at-large teams are selected, then the tournament will be seeded using the same criteria with a "new pool" made up of the eight teams.
