IMPROMPTU & DIALOGUE PARTICIPANTS:


- Register at the top of the long hall between the commons and pool/gym at 11:00 a.m.

Event Descriptions



Culture Trivia

Students take a 50-question test based on the cultures of their target language. Most of the multiple choice questions are taken from Teachers Discovery Culture Trivia. Students in 1st and 2nd levels take the test in English, while 3rd and 4th level students take the test in their target language.

Poetry Recitation

Students memorize and deliver classic and contemporary poems in their target language. They recite two poems -one required and one alternate of their choice from an approved list. Students are judged on memorization, pronunciation, delivery and expression.

Dialogues & Impromptu

Students use their knowledge and language skills to respond to real-world questions. After each student or pair of students (for dialogues) selects a different question, they have two minutes to prepare. This contest is a true test of a student's fluency and spontaneity in the target language.
