### **Scoring Skiing**

#### **Individual Awards**

Racers are awarded medals based on their order of finish in the race - in the state meet, the top 10 in each event will receive an award.

In addition, there will be individual medals awarded members of the 1st and 2nd place relay teams, and members of the teams placing 1st and 2nd place overall.

An All-State team composed of the top ten individuals overall will receive a certificate and the top skier will be declared "Skimeister".

#### **Team Awards**

There will be 1st and 2nd place team trophies awarded for both boys and girls. A first place plague for the highest scoring 2A/3A team for boys and girls.

#### Other Awards

ASAA recognizes a Good Sport Team, chosen from among participating schools with at least four skiers. This award recognizes the good citizenship and sportsmanship demonstrated throughout the whole season. Good Sport Team members are selected by each qualifying team's head coach.

An Academic Award is presented to the team with the highest GPA.
